\***Womens field** will be scored separately. (W1/2/3 & W4) Cash prizes are for top 3 W1/2/3 finishers. Women 4 - medals to nightly top 3 point getters.

Men Cat 5 will only be able to race in 4/5 race if Cat 5 race reaches 50 rider max limit.

**Points Format:** Sprint every 3 laps, points for top 4 in each sprint (5,3,2,1)  
Coaches may ride in Cat 5, Cat 4 and Women's races with their riders under the stipulation that they do not affect the outcome of the race (i.e. cannot participate in breakaways or sprints). **Coaches must register as such and pay a \$3 fee.**



Start times will vary and race lengths will increase as more daylight becomes available.
